We also aim to entertain, as well as learn, share and collaborate. Events featuring a guest speaker or panels will feature a topic of choice.

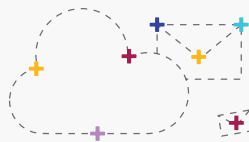
We plan to move the gatherings around each Australian state, coming together, and sharing and refining our knowledge and insights with our fellow practitioners.
